



Labelling School Uniform

All uniform items of clothing should be clearly labelled with a boy's name as indicated below. Label location is either on the front (white) or inside (yellow) of the uniform.

Labels should be sewn onto garments. Please do not use iron on labels.

Other items

- Sports Equipment – Sticky labels in a visible position
- Other equipment – Sticky labels in a visible position
- Footwear – Sticky labels on inside heel and initials on tongue
- Towel – Large label attached to the short side of towel
- Duvet, pillows and covers – Large label in visible position on short side
- Home clothes – Small labels inside garments
